Introduction:

The Argentine Aeromodelling Federation is formally presenting this proposal with the prospect of organizing the Free Flight World Championship for the year 2005.

We, respectfully ask every S/C member for your support to approve our petition.

With the experience of having organized 1989 World Championship, we are ready to offer Argentine's hospitality and support, good weather and superb flying fields at a very reasonable cost. We believe we have the experience, the ability and the human resources needed to organize the event.

Argentina's large free fliers base warrants accurate and experimented timekeeping. Every timekeeper will be a trained competition free flyer. Championship authorities are also Argentine Federation chairmen, warranting full support to the organization.

To repeat this experience will be very helpful for promoting free flight activity not only in Argentina but also in our limit countries like Brasil, Chile and Uruguay.

Contests will be run under the FAI Sporting Code Section 4 regulations.

General organization will closely follow the CIAM guide for organizers of outdoor free flight competitions.

Date:

May 23 to May 28, 2005.

According to meteorological data provided by Argentine Air Force Meteorological Office in 1988, May is the best month of the year when we can expect the most favorable conditions for our activity.

Entry fees:

It's very difficult to estimate an entry fee with 3 years in advance.
Our compromise is not to charge any more than an average of the last three
World Championships.
Full lodging rates will be probably below this range.

Transportation:

Free transportation will be provided to and from the flying field.

Flying site:

It is the same that was previously used in the 1989 World Championship and more than 12 times on Argentine Nationals and World Cup events.

It is located in La Cruz, department of Embalse, province of Cordoba, at about 750 Km. away from Buenos Aires and 130 Km. from city of Cordoba. Both cities have international airports.

The flying field is a large 4 x 4.5 Km flat and unobstructed area that belongs to the Argentine Air Force.

Refreshment, toilet and first aid facilities will be provided both, in the flying site and in the Air Base.

The field will be available for practice from May 20th.

Accommodation

Delegations will be hosted at the Embalse Turistic Complex, 20 minutes from the flying field. Two of the seven hotels will be used, on a two men per room basis.

Embalse area has many low rate and high quality hotels.

Breakfast and dinner will be served at hotels and packed lunches will be supplied for competition days.

Opening and Closing ceremonies will take place at the Embalse Sport Center (aprox. 2 km. away from hotels).

Model processing will be held on the sporting dome of the same center.

All these places proved to be appropriate in the 1989 World Championship.
